JOINING INSTRUCTIONS: ORIENTATION PROGRAMS FOR NEWLY INDUCTED ACs & PRINCIPALS OF KVS

General

1. In accordance with guidelines of KVS letter *ibid*, the orientation program for newly inducted Assistant Commissioners and Principals of KVS will be conducted at state of art campus at SelaQui, Dehradun. The program will be conducted in a residential mode over 12 working days in two batches as under:-

- ✚ Batch I – May 02 to 13, 2016, 51 participants
- ✚ Batch II – May 16 to 27, 2016, 50 participants

Aim

2. To lay down guidelines for participants to plan and equip themselves to undergo the orientation program at SelaQui Campus.

About SelaQui Campus

3. The SelaQui campus spread over 52 acres is located about 20 km from Dehradun on National Highway 72, connecting Dehradun with Paonta Sahib..

4. The campus ensures security and safety of the residents. Medical facilities supported by a six bedded school infirmary, available throughout

the day. The residential quarters are air conditioned and are supported by rich infrastructure and excellent facilities for sports like cricket, football, basketball, shooting, horse riding, swimming pool, golf, tennis etc. Those interested may make use of these facilities.

5. SelaQui International School, a boarding school matching international standards and DPSG, Dehradun, a day school are co-located at SelaQui Campus.

Broad Frame Work of Orientation Program

6. Each batch may be divided into two groups for some sessions for better comprehension and value additions. The broad frame work of 12 working days orientation program is as under:-

- School Leadership and Management – 6 days
- KVS integrated training – 2 days
- Visit local KVs - 2days
- Boot Camp – 2 days

Program Pedagogy

7. Pedagogical interventions, based on Reflection, Interaction and Collaboration are carried out through:-

- Experiential Learning
- Co-operative and Collaborative Learning
- Case Studies, Worksheets
- Project-Based Learning
- Reading and Reflective Writing
- Informed Group Discussions
- Role Plays, Presentations

Pre and Post Assignments

8. There will be pre and post assignments of the orientation program. These will be attempted by the participants online. The participants will be able to attempt these through UN and password generated for each participant. More details will be shared with all concerned in due course.

Boarding and Lodging

9. The participants would be accommodated in hostel in the campus, on sharing basis and dine in the cafeteria. Participants are not required to pay charges for boarding and lodging. Veg and non- veg option is available for meals.
